هذه المقبرة أنشأها غانم بن جزية وأرسكسة بنت تيم، القائد. بنيت على رؤما وكتب أخويها. ويخص غانم الجزء الثالث من المقبرة والعقد. كما يخص أرسكسة ثلثي المقبرة والعقد ونصيبها من الفتحات الجدارية في الجانب الشرقي حيث الفتحات هناك، أما غانم فله جزؤه من الفتحات على الجهة الشرقية الجنوبية وما فيه من فتحات لهم ولأطفالهم، جيلاً بعد جيل في شهر طيبة، في السنة الخامسة والأربعين من حكم الحارثة، ملك الأنباط المحب لشعبه، أفتح بن (عبد عبادة) النحات، نحتها.

THIS TOMB WAS CONSTRUCTED BY GHEANEM, S/O GEZIAH AND ARSIXH D/O TIM, THE COMMANDER, BUILT ON? WHOSE TWO BROTHERS ROMA AND KALIAB THE THIRD PORTION OF THE TOMB AND THE ARCH SHALL BE ALLOCATED TO GHEANEM WHILE ARSIXH SHALL HAVE TWO THIRD OF THE TOMB AND THE ARCH. AS WELL AS HER SHARE OF THE WALL SLOTS IN THE EASTERN SIDE WHILE GHEANEM SHALL HAVE THE SLOTS LOCATED IN THE SOUTH EASTERN SIDE. ALL OTHER SLOTS SHALL BE THEIRS AND THEIR CHILDREN, GENERATION AFTER GENERATION ON THE MONTH OF TAIBA, THE FORTY FIFTH YEAR OF THE REIGN OF ARETAS. THE KING OF NABATAEANS WHO ADORES HIS PEOPLE. CARVED BY AFTA, S/O (ABD EBADA); THE SCULPTURE.

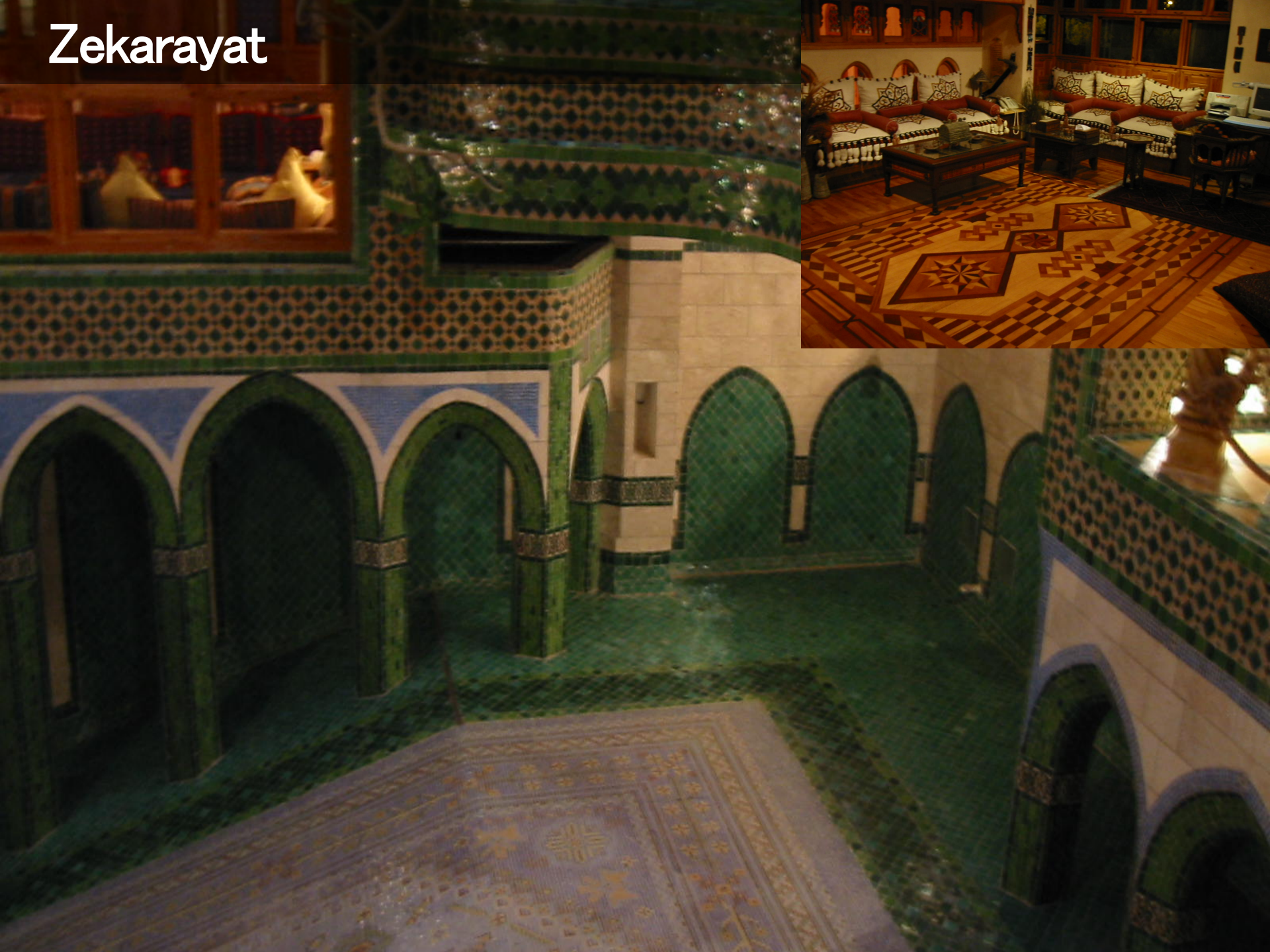

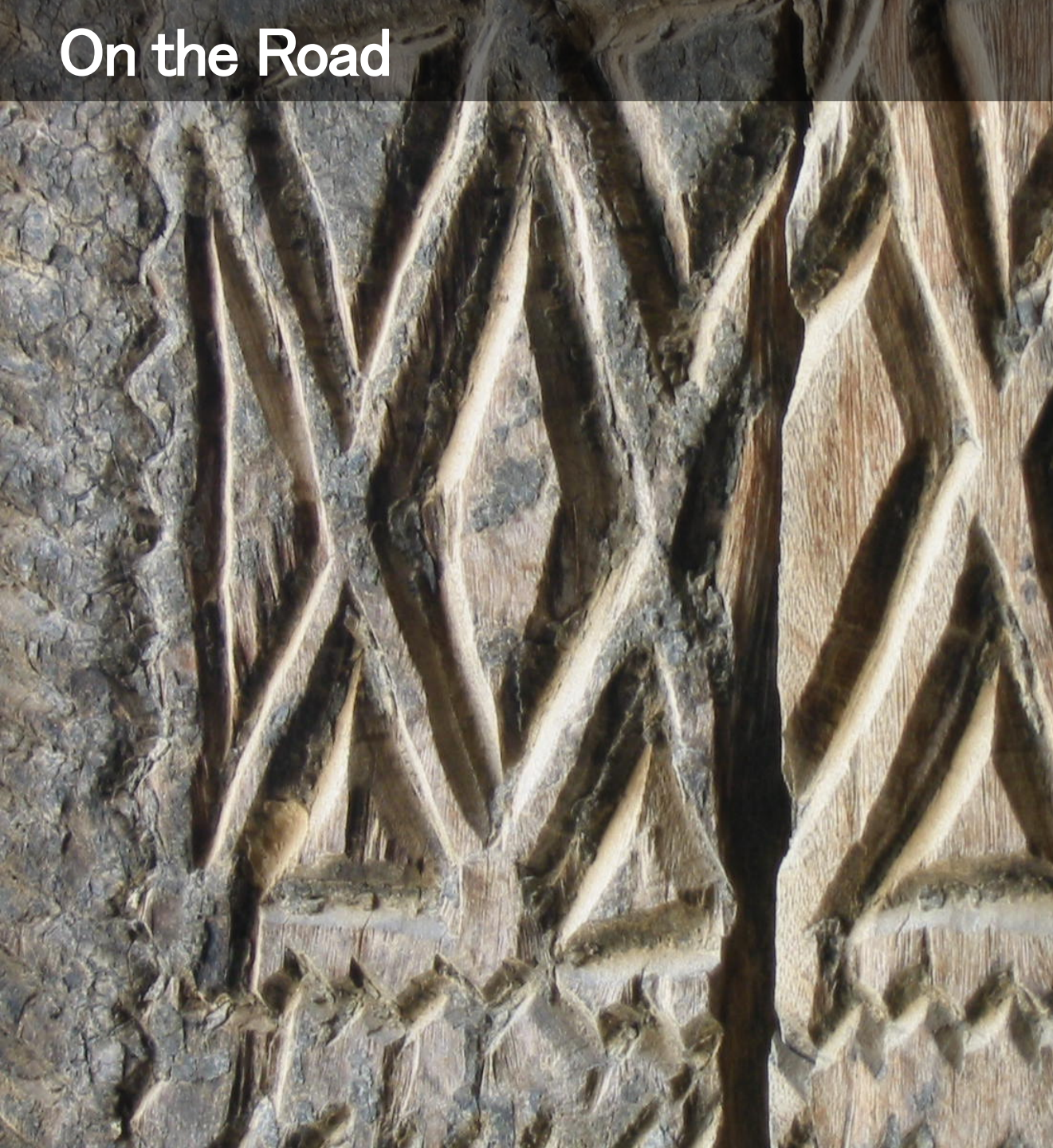
